What is Microsoft 365

The way we work is changing. We're no longer based in our offices and at our desks. Working outside of normal office hours, in our homes, and on multiple devices are now requirements rather than luxuries.

However, granting this flexibility and allowing employees to work outside of the traditional office format poses risk to your company data.

The allowance of technological freedom brings a whole host of new challenges – ensuring consistency across multiple devices, juggling work and personal apps, and ensuring employees can work from any location – all whilst navigating an ever evolving regulatory and compliance landscape. Finding this balance between freedom and control, and facing these new challenges with confidence is made easy with Microsoft 365.

Microsoft 365 is a suite of services that includes access to Office applications, plus other productivity and security tools. These services are Cloud-based meaning that they 'live' in the Cloud (a Microsoft datacentre) and you access them via an internet connection.

Microsoft 365 has many different plans to choose from, each suitable for different types and sizes of business. The plans include services such as Hosted Email with Exchange Online, Teams, SharePoint, OneDrive, and Office.

Microsoft 365 is more than just these services though; with the likes of Azure Information Protection, email encryption, and Mobile Device Management, Microsoft 365 is a complete package that presents staff with the freedom they desire alongside security features to keep that freedom secure.

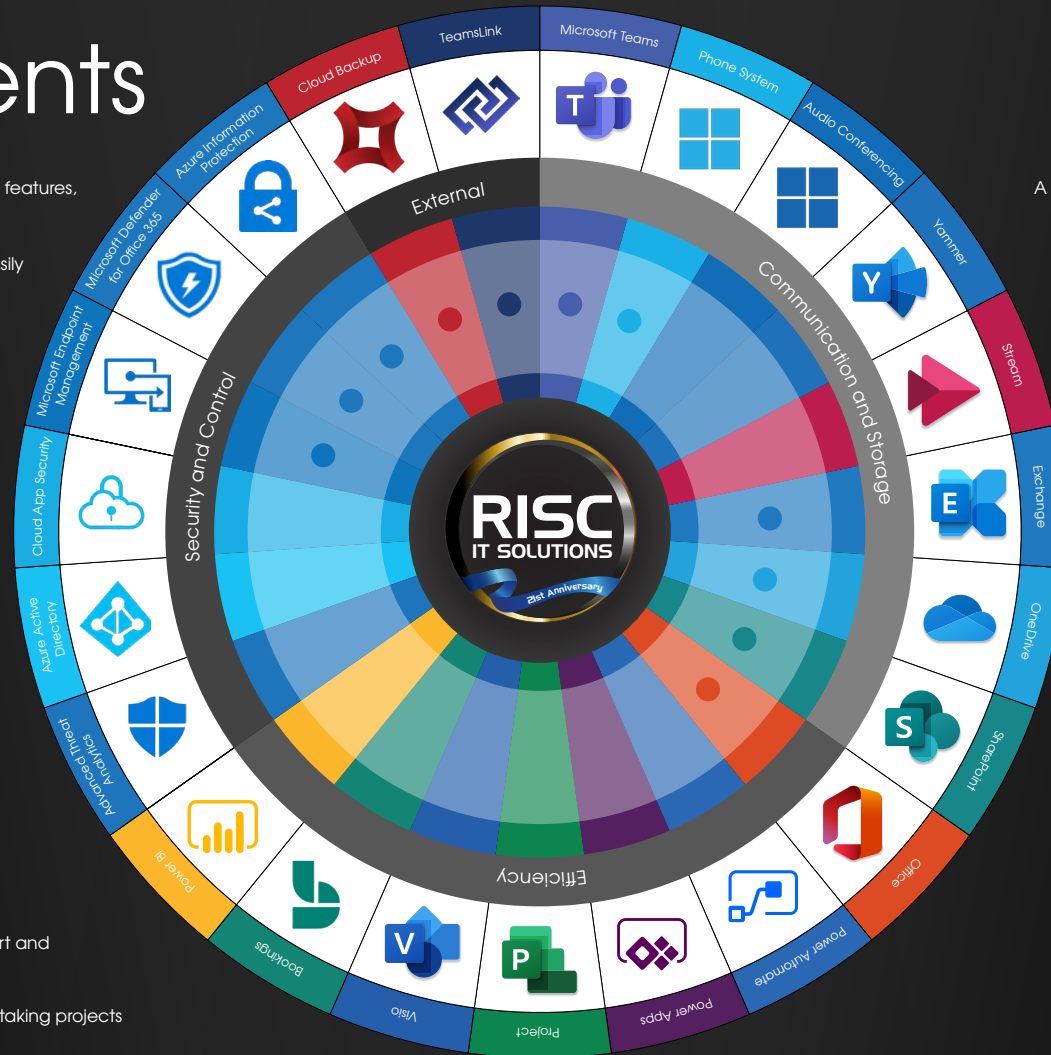
An online service that allows your customers to easily book time and services with you.

Phone System

Use Microsoft Teams as your phone system for easy, integrated calling.

Audio Conferencing

Host group calls and meetings with non-Teams users using dial-in.

Yammer

A corporate social media platform allowing collaboration between colleagues.

Stream

Deliver live and on-demand video to your organisation any time on any device.

Exchange

Access your email on virtually any device in virtually any location.

OneDrive

A Cloud storage platform that allows you to work on and share your files from virtually any device.

SharePoint

Store documents in the Cloud for seamless collaboration with your colleagues.

Office

Word, Excel, PowerPoint etc. – your favourite work apps accessible anywhere through the Cloud.

Power Automate

Create automated workflows to connect your favourite apps.

Power Apps

Build unique low-code apps to simplify processes and tackle your organisation's challenges.

2. Navigating your way through the Products

Communication and Storage

Having a workforce that's based in multiple locations and across multiple devices demands tools that allow successful communication.

Outlook, Teams and Yammer all aid communication, whilst OneDrive and SharePoint allow storage and collaboration. OneDrive provides a storage space per user and SharePoint allows company-wide access to documents and real-time collaboration with colleagues.

SharePoint works behind the scenes of Teams, a group-oriented communication space that allows the sharing of documents and links. Teams has developed into the heart of Microsoft 365: it's a central hub for everyone to communicate and work from. Both external and Microsoft apps can be accessed through Teams, allowing you to keep everything you need in one easy access, easy-to-use space.

Outlook is the email platform that we're all familiar with. Powered by Cloud-based Exchange Online, Outlook offers email, shared calendars, and security features on any device, anywhere with an internet connection.

Office Suite

There are two types of Office Suite in Microsoft 365: local copies and web apps.

The web apps can be downloaded on up to 5 PCs/Macs, Tablets, and Phones. This means that rather than being accessed through a web browser, the Office Suite apps are downloaded onto your device, allowing offline work. You will still receive feature updates and security patches for your downloaded versions.

The web app versions are only accessible via a web browser, so can be accessed on any device, anywhere with an internet connection. The web apps are a 'condensed' version, so do not have the full functionality that's available in the downloadable apps. Please note that Access and Publisher are not available as web apps.

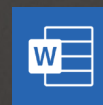

Efficiency

Your staff need to work efficiently; after all, the use of technology is designed to aid easy working, not hinder it. Power Automate allows you to connect your different apps through automation. For example, you might automate a notification every time a colleague modifies a SharePoint document that you've authored. Power Automate can be used in hundreds of unique ways to aid all aspects of your work. Similarly, Power Apps allows you to create low-code apps that solve your business challenges enabling greater efficiency.

Project allows the easy management of all aspects of projects from start to finish, all in one place. Visio allows you to create advanced diagrams and flowcharts. View and analyse different data sources in insightful ways with Power BI, helping you gain deeper understanding and aiding growth. Bookings is an easy way for people inside and outside of your company to view your availability and book time with you, so you can focus on the meeting rather than organising the meeting.

Security and Control

With freedom comes more risk. Microsoft excels at providing security solutions to ensure that working freely also means working more securely. Advanced Threat Analytics works to create user profiles in order to monitor behaviour – it protects against cyberattacks and threats by recognising behaviour outside of these normal patterns.

Microsoft Endpoint Management allows administrators to manage users' devices – employee and business owned – by enforcing policies and conditions before access to company data is granted. It also keeps work and personal apps separate so there's no business data misuse and, equally, no invasion of personal apps.

For email security, Microsoft Defender for Office 365 scans attachments and links in emails to see if they're malicious and denies access if they are. Azure Information Protection allows users to classify and label emails and documents so that they don't get into the wrong hands, protecting your business information.

External Add-ons

There are two products in particular that work hand in hand with Microsoft 365 but are not from Microsoft.

Cloud Backup from Redstor allows you to backup and restore your Microsoft 365 data with total ease. Adding an additional layer of security to your OneDrive, SharePoint, Exchange Online, and Teams data, Redstor allows you to choose which data you want to back up and how often. Restoration of data is easy through the management portal allowing you to choose which data to restore, from when, and where to. Data is encrypted at all points of the process – at source, in transit, and at rest – to keep it safe.

TeamsLink enhances Teams' telephony functionality with a comprehensive, enterprise-grade phone system which is fully-managed and hosted on TeamsLink's servers. The management portal is intuitive and easy to use allowing you to visually see your call setup, ring and hunt groups, and users. It also has the option of call recording allowing you to capture and record all communications and interactions within Teams for true peace of mind and easy compliance management.

Communication

As the ultimate communication package, TeamsLink, Teams, and Phone System provide a comprehensive, enterprise grade phone solution that's suitable for all types and size of company.

Natively in Teams, you can video and audio call other Teams users, both inside and outside your organisation. Phone system adds another layer to this allowing you to use Teams as your complete telephony solution replacing any on-premise PBX system.

You can make, receive, and transfer calls from Teams and regular phone numbers. Because it is integrated with Microsoft 365, it appears in Teams as though it is native, and is easy to use. It recognises when users in your address book are in your organisation or not, and whether they are a Teams user or not, displaying the appropriate calling options available.

TeamsLink takes that one step further, providing a comprehensive enterprise-grade phone system that's hosted on TeamsLink's own servers. The management portal is easy to use and allows you to organise multi-layered call routing, and ring and hunt groups from a visual and intuitive portal.

There is also the option of FCA and MiFID II compliant call recording, allowing you to record, archive, retrieve, search, and monitor multiple modes of communication including calls, chats, and screen shares.

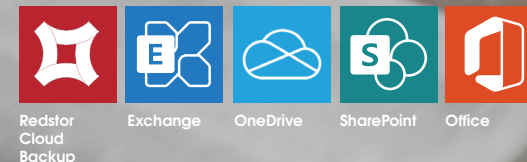
Working efficiently, collaboratively, and securely is easy with Microsoft 365 and Redstor Cloud Backup. Using the Office apps you're familiar with, you can work with internal and external users easily on documents through SharePoint. All your documents are accessible through your Microsoft account on any device with internet.

Even though your documents are accessible in many places, they only live in one: the Cloud. If a user accidentally deletes a file from a device, it will be replicated across your entire Microsoft 365 account. Redstor mitigates this by providing an additional layer of security, backing up your Exchange, OneDrive, SharePoint, and Teams data. You can choose which data you want to backup and when; that data is then encrypted at source, in transit, and at rest in a secure primary datacentre and also a mirror datacentre.

Recovery is easy through the Redstor Cloud Backup management portal: just select which backup you want to restore, from when, and where to. Realistically, there is no limit to the amount of data you can backup, making this a solution that's suitable for all businesses.

Security

Accessibility and collaboration are essential for today's workforce, but to think that this doesn't come without additional risk is naïve. Microsoft recognise this and provide security features to keep your data safe. Microsoft Endpoint Management provides comprehensive, yet easy to use, management of your workforce's devices. You're able to push out policies that keep work data completely separate to personal data, meaning you can maintain absolute security without being invasive.

Advanced Information Protection allows you to track your company data, and rescind access if required. You're also able to apply labels to your documents to ensure they are only accessible by certain groups, departments or individuals. It will also prevent copying and pasting, forwarding, taking screenshots or even printing, keeping that information absolutely secure.

Phishing attacks are a huge threat to organisations, and once again, human error is often the catalyst. Clicking on that dodgy link because you were distracted can have devastating effects on your organisation. Microsoft Defender for Office 365 scans all links and attachments sent to you and categorises them into safe or malicious. If the attachment is safe, you will have access as usual; if it's found to be malicious, you won't be able to access it and it will be detonated.

Microsoft Endpoint Management, Advanced Information Protection, and Microsoft Defender for Office 365 are the three Microsoft security products we recommend every organisation has. Using these will give you complete protection across all devices whilst also allowing collaboration and flexibility.

Anywhere access

Microsoft 365 can be accessed on any device with internet. One user licence can be applied to 5 different devices (laptops, PCs, mobile phones, and tablets) which will all sync together, so switching between offices and home, and from device to device is seamless. Your team can work more easily, collaborate better, and enjoy the freedom to work from where they feel most comfortable.

Easy collaboration

Microsoft 365 makes internal and external collaboration easy, so you can work as a Team regardless of how much distance is between you. Video, audio conferencing and instant messaging are available through Teams – you can share your screen on a call and take control of a shared screen as well. SharePoint allows you to collaborate on documents simultaneously, either in the app itself, online, or through Teams.

Security and control

Collaborative working doesn't mean sacrificing security, so there are plenty of advanced security features to keep your data safe. Microsoft Defender for Office 365 prevents malware and phishing attacks by scanning all links and attachments in Outlook and Teams, and detonating where necessary. Microsoft Endpoint Management allows the management of both company-owned and personal devices keeping your data secure across all devices. Viruses are often caused by vulnerabilities in software, so a huge benefit of Microsoft 365 and Microsoft Endpoint Management is the ability to push out patches and upgrades remotely.
